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As a final project, you will prepare a slide show in Spanish with the following requirements:

1. The slideshow is about you, your interests, your hobbies, etc.
2. There must be 20 slides in the show. Five should be about your past (use preterite or imperfect), ten about your present (use present), and five about your future (use ir form + $\mathrm{a}+$ infinitive). The slide must have a different verb on it to count. If you have an intro or conclusion slide without a verb, it will not count. Each slide will have one sentence to a page.
3. Use graphics and sound along with interesting transitions, animations, etc. If you use music, it must be appropriate or you will get a zero score.
4. When you are finished, you must print out a black and white copy of the show with six slides to a page.
5. Present your show in Spanish. Seniors will go first.
