It is a prevention-oriented way for school personnel to Organize evidence-based practices Improve their implementation of those practices Maximize academic & social behavior outcomes for students It is a data-driven approach designed to help schools to Efficiently educate all students, including students with challenging social behaviors Adopt and sustain the use of effective instructional practices And most importantly, PBIS supports the success of ALL students!	 Decide What is Important for students to know (behavioral expectations – local standards for student behavior, reading, & math). Teach What is Important for students to know (high quality instruction = differentiation). Acknowledge students for demonstrating positive behaviors. Keep Track of how students are doing through data. Make Changes according to the results. 	 Office Discipline Referral (ODR): A form used to collect data on targeted behaviors Cricket Caughtcha's: Green slips used to acknowledge students for exhibiting desired behavioral expectations. Student Matrix: This chart details both the academic and social expectations of our students.
