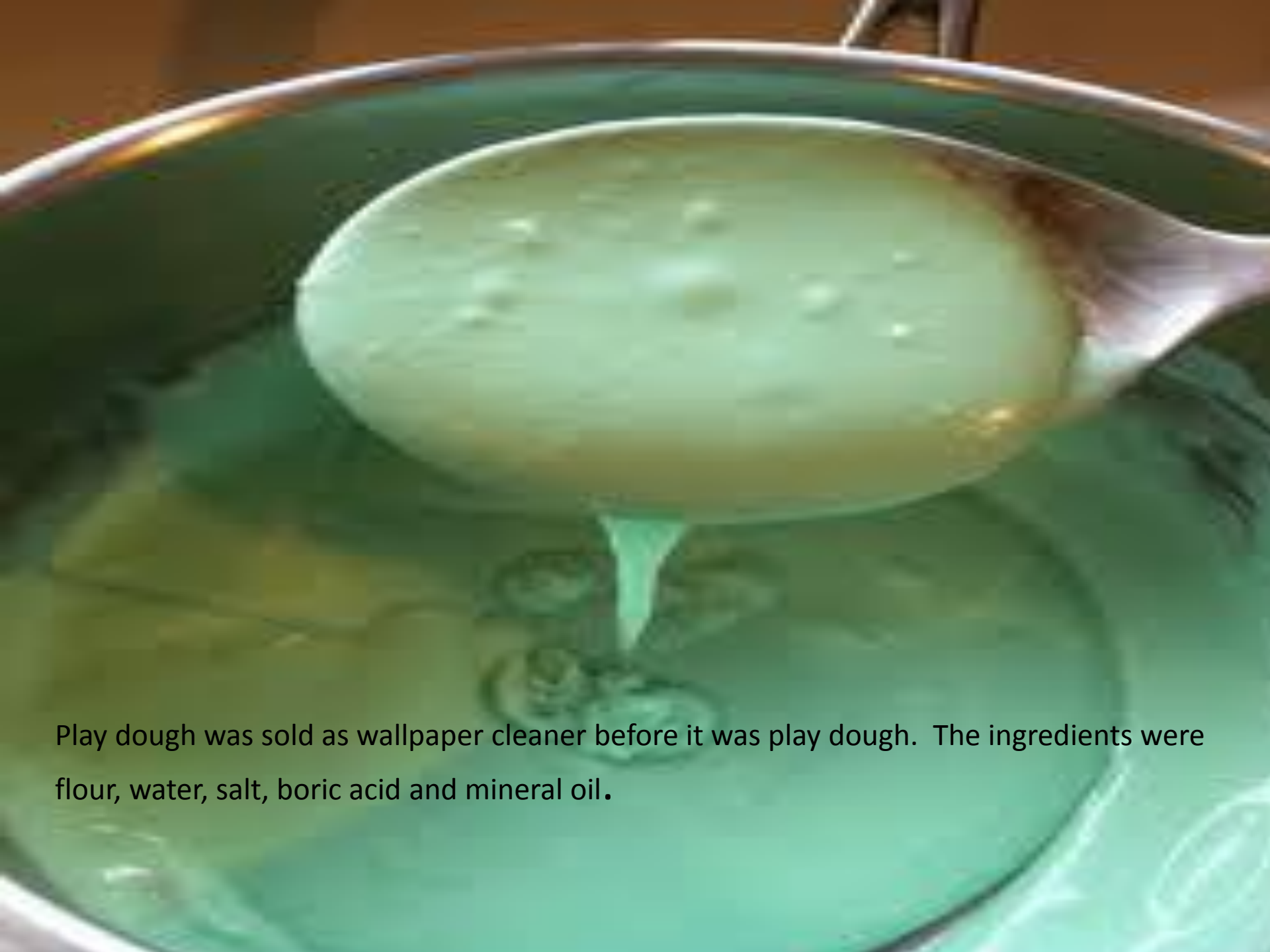
Who Invented

Play dough was accidentally made in 1930's by Noah McVicker in Cincinnati, Ohio.

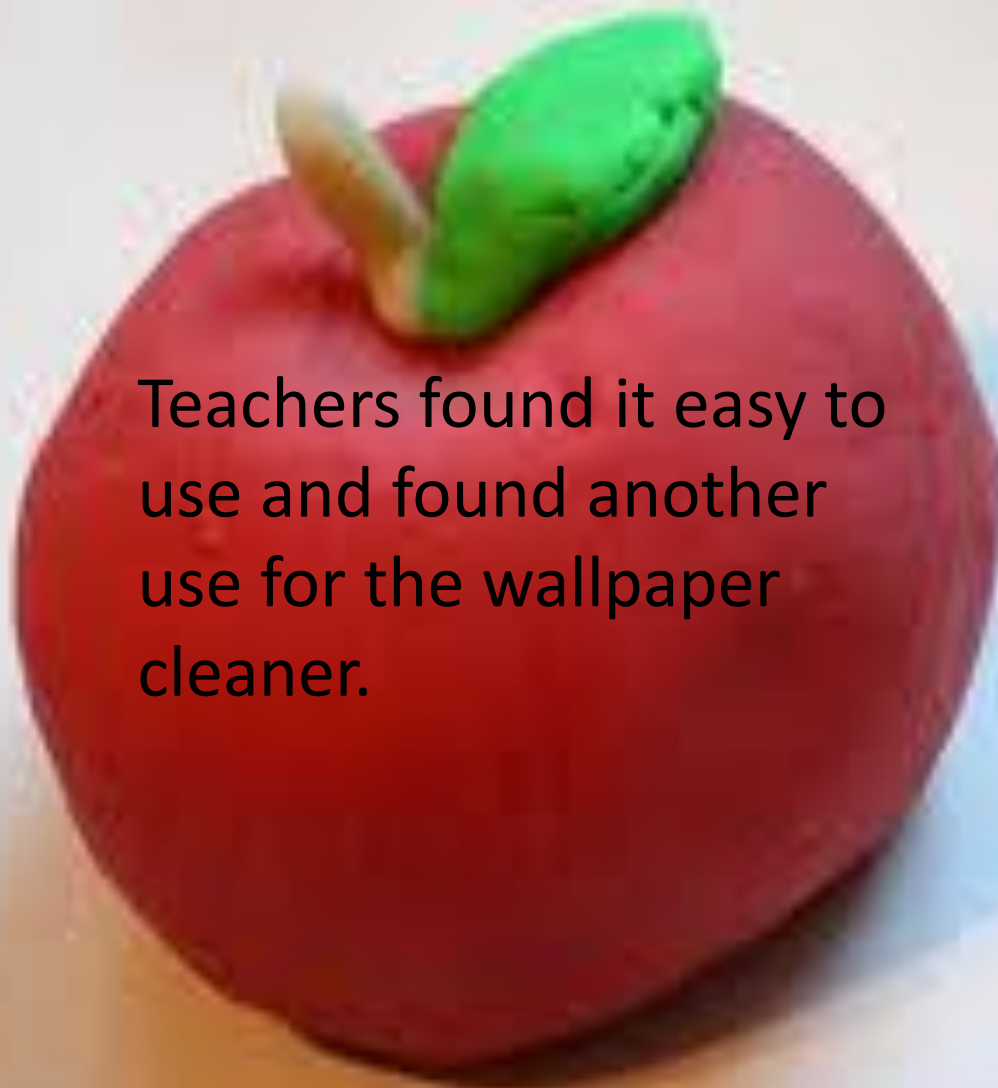




Play dough was sold as wallpaper cleaner before it was play dough. The ingredients were flour, water, salt, boric acid and mineral oil.

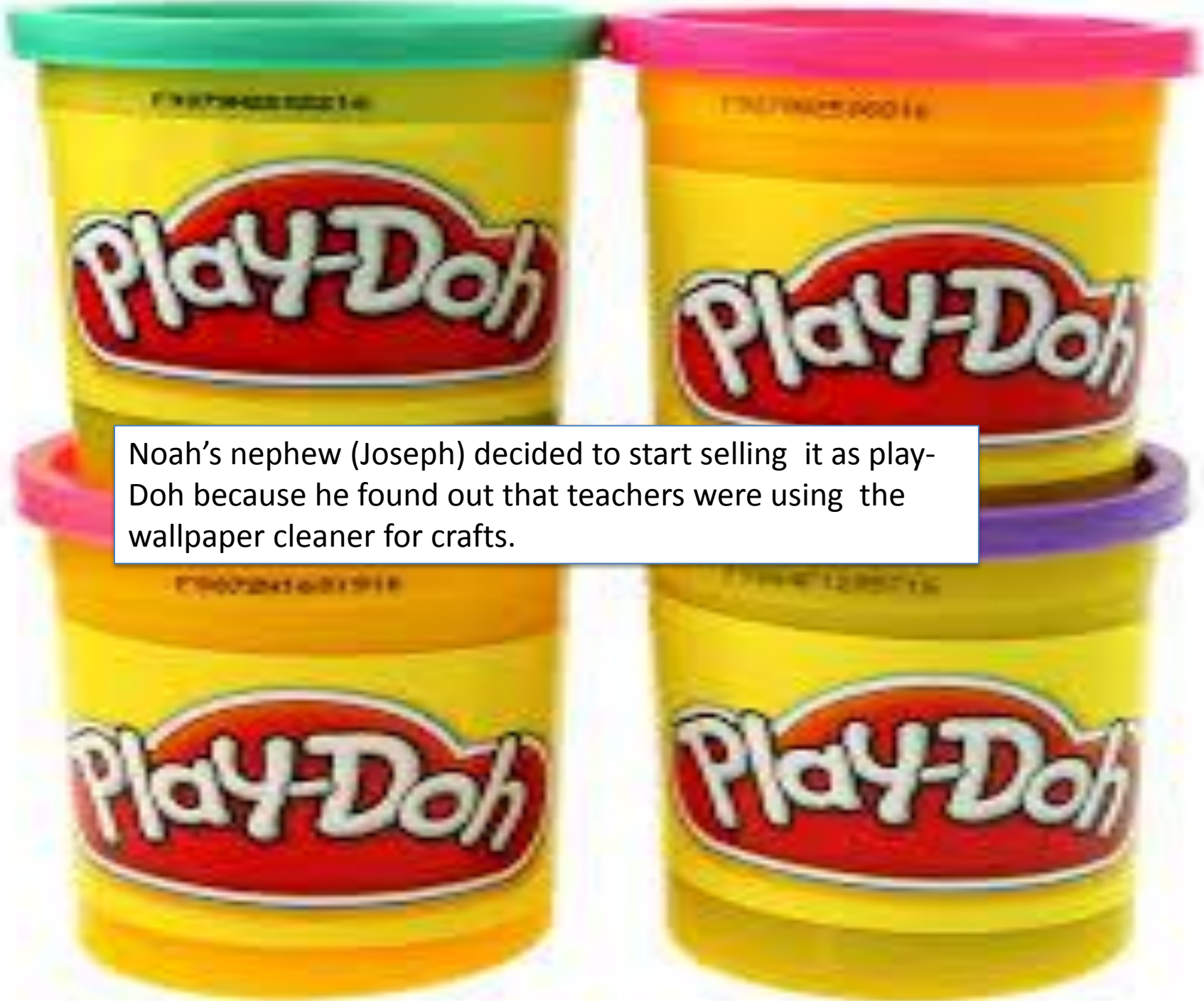
Play dough was non- toxic, doesn't stain, and re-useable.
