

Ms. Shew's Expectations of All Students

Personal Responsibility – Be accountable for action, choices, and the results

- ✓ Be on time - When the bell rings, you should be in your seat ready to begin class. You will be marked "tardy" if you come in late and you must obtain a pass from the teacher that released you late or from the office (excused or unexcused) – You will not be admitted to class without a pass. After three tardies you will be assigned a 15-minute detention. For every time you are tardy after that, you will receive a 15-minute detention for each occurrence
- ✓ Be prepared - bring materials with you. You will not be allowed to leave to go back to your locker. Assume you will need your book and any class resources every day
- ✓ Be an active learner – Participate in class, ask questions, expand your knowledge
- ✓ Complete Assignments - All assignments are to be completed and ready to turn in, check, or discuss at the **BEGINNING** of class
- ✓ No late work will be accepted (excused absences excluded)

Respect – Show consideration, appreciation, acceptance, and be safe

- ✓ Be an active listener
- ✓ Consider others viewpoints
- ✓ Stay focused on topic of discussion
- ✓ Use school appropriate language
- ✓ Be considerate of others, personal space, and property
- ✓ Respect others' right to learn
- ✓ Please leave all food, drink, or candy in your locker due to the computers
- ✓ Cell Phones – I don't mind if they are out, but that is the limit – they may NOT be used for the calculator function
- ✓ If you borrow any supplies (markers, pencils, hole puncher) please return it to where you found it
- ✓ If you are assigned a text book for the semester/year you are responsible for keeping the book covered
- ✓ You will pay for any damages caused by you to school-owned property, including computer components, textbooks
- ✓ Please do not change the settings on the monitors or unplug the cords on the back of the computers
- ✓ Games are not allowed to be played on the computers – educational purposes only
- ✓ The Internet is off-limits unless given permission to use it
- ✓ You are allowed to print ONLY school related materials

Integrity – Be honest, sincere, and kind in words and actions.

- ✓ Do your own work
- ✓ Cheating or attempting to cheat will result in failing grades. Each circumstance will be reviewed independently
- ✓ Be patient and tolerant with self and others
- ✓ Share responsibilities
- ✓ Please keep your returned, graded papers until the end of the grading period (quarter or semester) to ensure grades are correctly entered and reported
- ✓ Take responsibility for your workspace – push in your chair, throw away trash on your way out
- ✓ Your name must be on your paper or you will receive a "0" for that assignment, test or quiz

Determination – Set goals and meet expectations

- ✓ Be organized
- ✓ You must have your agenda with you at all times and write assignments and due dates in agenda
- ✓ Manage your time
- ✓ Learn from mistakes
- ✓ Make an honest effort
- ✓ Request help when needed - Ask questions if you don't understand directions or assignments

Excellence – Strive to do the best at all times

- ✓ Produce quality work
- ✓ All work should be either word processed or written legibly – if I can't read it, I can't grade it and you will receive a failing grade. I reserve the right to not accept homework that is done sloppy or with an unacceptable level of effort. If given a second change to do the assignment, points will be taken off for not doing it correctly on the first attempt.
- ✓ Challenge yourself to take a chance
- ✓ Use school resources to ensure success
- ✓ Commit to be at school
- ✓ When you miss class due to illness, appointments, etc. it is YOUR responsibility to collect any make-up work
- ✓ Do not ask during class what you missed - See me before school or after school to discuss missed assignments
- ✓ You will have two days for each day of excused absence to get missing work turned
- ✓ Make-up work must be completed outside of class on your own time
- ✓ If you are absent the day before a test, you will be expected to take the test as scheduled
- ✓ Any homework that was due on the day you were absent must be turned in on the day you return for credit
