Language Arts: Language Arts is a combination of reading, spelling, and writing.

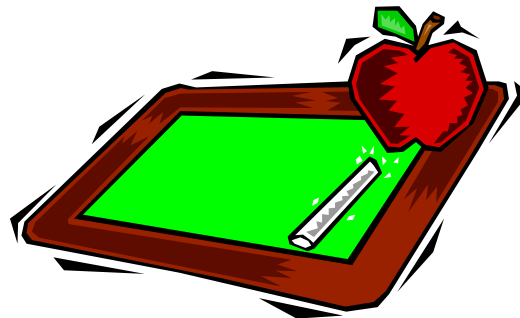
Math: Math is composed of working with numbers, story problems, calendar, patterning, adding, subtracting, graphing, measuring and geometry.
