



Some websites will automatically put in a name or type the name you want

Checking the "Show text?" box allows users to see the title of the tile on the Symbaloo page


You might want to assign colors for categories of tiles (i.e. all Math websites are blue)

Click “Share My Webmix”




After you click “Share my Webmix,” you will get a link to your Symbaloo page that you can copy or e-mail.

This is the link people will need to be able to use your Symbaloo.

Notice now you have a blue sideways V instead of the word "Share"

When you make changes to your Symbaloo, you NEED to click this icon and follow the next set on instructions.



Click "Update webmix" whenever you make changes that you want your viewers to see.
