### ***Fall Creek Middle School***

**Foundation** | We pride ourselves in providing high quality learning for all students in a warm, welcoming climate. We recognize that middle school is an important transition time for students as they become adolescents, and our priority is to provide an environment that supports personal, social, and emotional development alongside academics.

**Education** | Students at Fall Creek Middle School follow a block schedule, including Math, English and Language Arts (ELA), Science, Social Studies, Health, and Physical Education. In addition to the core classes, students have the opportunity to take exploratory courses such as Technical Education, Computer Science, Art, and Spanish. Fall Creek Middle School consistently meets or exceeds state academic standards in all categories. Fall Creek School District also offers alternative education experiences, including private, charter, and virtual schools, a parental choice program, and open enrollment.

**Experience** | Middle school students have the opportunity to participate in several extracurricular activities. Athletics give students a chance to try out various sports and learn fundamental skills of the sport along with building their values for teamwork, perseverance, and hard work. Middle school athletic offerings include: football, volleyball, cross country, basketball, and track and field. Additional extracurricular opportunities include: forensics, FFA, Students Advocating for Excellence (SAFE) and student council. Each of these unique programs offer students important learning experiences for building leadership, professional, and speaking skills.

**Demographics** | The 2023-2024 enrollment of Fall Creek Middle School is a total of 192 students. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade is made up of 31 males and 37 females, 7<sup>th</sup> grade has 33 males and 26 females, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade has 30 males and 35 females.
