## *Curriculum*

A minimum of 3.5 credits (7 scheduled classes) per semester are required of our students, seniors in good academic standing can have 6 scheduled classes. Students may also take credits via Early College Credit, Start College Now, transcribed courses, or via virtual school pending need and availability.

A minimum of 25 credits is **required for graduation**. Graduation requirements include: 4 credits English; 3 credits mathematics; 3 credits science; 3 credits social studies; 1.5 credits of physical education, .5 credits of personal finance, .5 credits of information processing, .5 credits of health, Capstone Project .5, 8.5 elective credits, a civics exam, and 30 hours of community service.

**Advanced Placement (AP)** courses that are offered include English Literature and Composition, Psychology, Statistics, Biology and Calculus AB. We also work with the Wisconsin Virtual School to offer more AP courses.
